III. Other

1. Limitations on the dimensions of checked baggage: The sum of the length, width and height of each piece of ordinary checked baggage shall not be less than 60 cm or 24 inches, and shall not exceed 203 cm or 80 inches, including pulleys and handles. Items beyond the above restrictions shall not be transported as baggage.

2. Limitations on the weight of checked baggage: Each piece of normal checked baggage must not be less than 2kg or 4lbs and must not exceed 32kg or 70lbs.

3. Limitations on the number of pieces of checked baggage: There is no maximum limitation on the number of pieces of checked baggage per passenger (including ordinary and special baggage). Passengers who need to carry the checked baggage that exceeds the free baggage allowances shown on the ticket, the seventh and more additional pieces of baggage (including ordinary and special baggage) shall apply to the Air China ticketing offices in advance, and such baggage can only be checked in if the flight capacity permits. Meanwhile, Air China does not promise that the above luggage will arrive at the destination on the same aircraft as the passengers.

4. Membership Benefits: PhoenixMiles Lifetime Platinum Card, Platinum Card, Gold Card, Silver Card passengers can check in an additional piece of baggage for free when traveling in first class or business class, with each piece weighting no more than 32KG (70 pounds). Passengers can also check in an additional piece of baggage for free when traveling in Premium Economy Class, or Economy Class, with each piece weighing no more than 23KG (50 pounds); Star Alliance Gold Card passengers can check in an additional piece of baggage for free, with each piece weighing no more than 23KG (50 pounds), regardless of the class they are in.

5. For infant passengers a foldable stroller, cradle, or baby car safety seat can be checked for free.

6. For the free baggage allowances for student passengers (STU), labor passengers (LBR), seafarer passengers (SEA), and emigrant passengers (EMI) what is shown on tickets or what passengers are informed of at the time of ticket purchase apply.
